Wauseon LWCF Grant

In 2010, Reveille was retained by the City of Wauseon to help in attaining grant funds to help make various improvements at park facility across the City.

Two promising programs, the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund, and the Nature Works program (State of Ohio) were designated as the programs of choice in attaining funding for the City's Biddle Park facility and Trailhead facility.

The improvements made at Dorothy B. Biddle Park are a culmination of over 13 or more years of planning. What started as a financial contribution from the estate of Dorothy Biddle and nurturing from the City of Wauseon and Rotary International has now become what is now called the "Field of Dreams" through assistance of numerous organizations and volunteers. A \$70,000 grant was requested for this facility and an award of \$70,000 was made in August 2010.

Also in August, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources notified Wauseon that it was selected to receive a Nature Works grant to help offset costs affiliated with the expansion of the Trailhead project.
