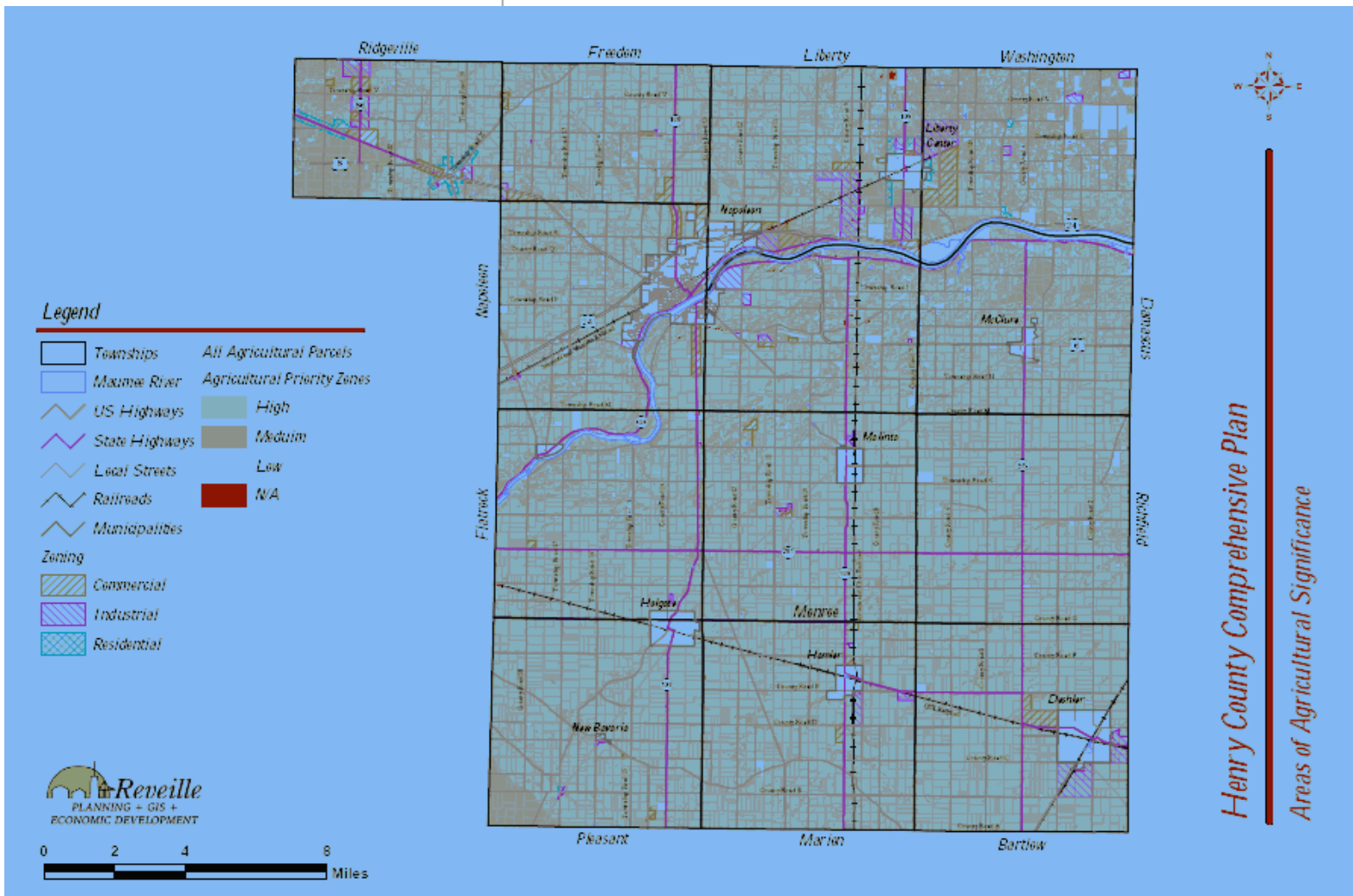

Henry County Comprehensive Plan

Not unlike many Ohio counties, Henry County is a predominantly rural community facing a time of transition. These impacts include loss of productive farm ground and soils, strip housing developments, and increased demand for potable water services, storm water management, and rural road improvements. Reveille was selected by the Board of County Commissioners to assist the Henry County Planning Commission in developing a new comprehensive plan that would replace the existing one completed in the early 1970s. Reveille worked closely with the Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee in formulating the plan and addressing such community issues as managed growth and development, concept and growth area boundaries, and transportation and infrastructure planning. Incorporated into the Plan was a thorough public input, review, and feedback process. This process included data from previous surveys and the Farmland Preservation Task Force Committee, the Reveille-developed County Community Survey, and a series of meetings held across the county.
